

Volkswagen LT: short or long wheelbase Panel Vans.

The range of LT panel vans clearly demonstrates the many advantages that the range offers.

The forward control design provides maximum available load space within compact overall dimensions.

Despite being only 484 cm (15'10½") long the short wheelbase LT panel van offers an enormous 7.85 m³ (277 ft³) of useable load space and 5.6 m² (60.3 ft²) floor area. The van's flat floor is 306 cm (5'11½") wide. Interior height is 146 cm (4'9").

The almost flat sides and square section design enables full utilisation of the load compartment and single rear wheels* means minimal wheel box intrusion.

Having a generous load space is fine but what about accessibility? Here the LT excels. The huge 180° opening double rear doors are 144 cm (4'8½") wide by 128 cm (4'2") high. Practically the full width of the vehicle. But that's not all:

Standard equipment includes a sliding side loading door that's 108 cm (3'6") wide and 128 cm (4'2") high. Renowned for its design, it can be opened from inside and out and takes up little extra space when opened. Important when

door to door delivering in busy roads and confined spaces. Once opened it is retained in place so it won't roll or blow shut.

Opening the side door reveals an easy access step to help you in and out, that's ergonomics working for you.

Loading height is only 69.5 cm (27.4 in) and there's a walk through from the cab between the two steel $\frac{1}{2}$ bulkheads to give quick access for fast deliveries.

The short wheelbase LT van's no lightweight either. Available as LT 28, 31 or 35, it offers GVWs from 3.18 tonnes to 3.5 tonnes and nominal payload capacity from 1.535 tonnes

to 1.835 tonnes.


Optional equipment includes full or half width bulkheads and second side loading door. But for those who need a little extra there's a high roof version.

With internal height of 187 cm (6'1") and full length roof extension, the high roof LT Panel Van offers a lofty 10.4 m³ (367 ft³) load space at little extra cost.


For those who need a lot more room to move there's the long wheelbase LT panel van.

The Volkswagen LT represents a significant advance in light truck design.



Although of conventional front mounted water cooled engine and rear wheel drive layout, its design incorporates many features that put it in the forefront of current commercial vehicle technology, particularly in the field of vehicle safety.

The high levels of inbuilt active (preventive) and passive safety features make the LT probably the safest commercial

vehicle available.

The powerful dual circuit servo assisted brake system with discs up front and self adjusting drums at the back, incorporates a brake pressure regulator to effectively apportion braking effort to the two circuits to obviate wheel lock-up and ensure safe sure stopping.


The strong full width front bumper is mounted on a deformation element and progressive deformation front frame members, which together with the rigid "safety cell" cab design, built-in roll over bar and door reinforcements absorb and transmit collision forces to computed fold areas. All

Dual circuit, servo-assisted, disc/drum brake system.


designed to afford maximum possible protection to occupants. A collapsible safety steering column gives added protection to the driver.

The front and rear suspension designs combine ride comfort with excellent handling characteristics. Hollow rubber spring aids are standard on the rear to give extra support. There's a stabiliser bar on the front and Panhard rod at the rear (on LT 28 and LT 31 models) to ensure maximum stability and low body roll, important for safe cornering and where high bodies are concerned. High body package standard on LT 35 and LT 45 chassis models providing additional stability

for larger bodies. Radial ply tyres are standard too.

The LT's powerful petrol and diesel engines and sturdy modern running gear with four and five speed transmission give lively performance and long service life. Beneath the LT's crisp good looks is a strong, welded semi-unitary design body and chassis that combines strength with low weight for maximum payload and minimum noise.

Additional external safety features include reversing lights (standard on all van models) and rear fog light.



Drive an LT and you'll be hooked

by the comfort, sheer good looks and well thought out design, making the LT a very versatile vehicle.

The LT's versatility is found in its special basic design concept: a powerful, solid chassis with a separate driver's cab. This allows all types of bodies and specialised equipment, permutations and combinations for individual re-

quirements.

With two wheelbases available of 2500 mm and 2950 mm, extra high roof models, the loading capacity of the LT offers nominal payloads from 1.5 to 2.5 tonnes depending on model and body.

The wide 180° opening rear doors and side loading door are standard on van models, allowing excellent side and



rear accessibility for loading, keeping an even distribution of load whilst unloading is made easier by the large sliding side door.

Chassis cab models are suited to accept any number of different types of bodies, from the straight box van or luton type, curtain sided types, flat bed, drop side or small tipper bodies for loose loads.

For operators requiring a vehicle that can carry plant and equipment and a working crew to sites away from base as in the case of local authority maintenance crews, then the LT Chassis Double Cab models offer the practical solution.

Whatever your needs from 3180 kg to 4500 kg GVW, the LT range of vehicles should suit.



The Volkswagen LT: makes light work of hard work.

The science of ergonomics has radically affected the design and layout of the LT cab.

The comprehensive controls are easily reached and can be operated quickly and with minimum effort. This means the driver gives full attention to the road ahead.

The dash panel features non-dazzle instruments and rocker switches marked with easily recognisable symbols for quick reading and operation.

Lights, main beam flashers, turn indicators, two speed

windscreen wipers and electric windscreen washers are all fingertip operated by steering column mounted stalks. The gear lever also falls easily to hand for quick confident shifting.

Foot pedals and steering wheel are positioned for use by everyone, short or tall. The anatomically designed driver's seat, adjustable for reach and rake ensures that the driver will always be comfortably in control. The passenger seat is anatomical too.

The LT's enormous, deep windscreen offers a remarkable field of vision. In addition generous side and rear windows, and large door mounted rear view mirrors give the LT's driver

excellent all round vision.

An effective heating and ventilation system with three speed blower keeps the driver comfortable and fresh, stale air being extracted through door mounted sliding vents. Dash mounted multi-directional fresh air vents give extra ventilation for the personal touch.

Special attention has been given to interior noise. The effective use of insulation material, particularly on the engine cowling, keeps things remarkably quiet.

Daily checks on oil and water can be carried out from the driver's seat by raising the engine cowl inspection panel. An

inspection cover in the dash panel also allows easy checking and filling of the brake fluid reservoir.

Major overhauls and maintenance are facilitated by the removal of the seats and engine cowl. This takes about a minute, giving remarkable engine and equipment access.

A striking feature of the LT cab is its roominess. Not only is it spacious, it's also fully trimmed. Standard equipment includes passenger seat, floor mats, door trim panels, headlining, sun visors, ash-tray, grab handle, engine cover and glove box. The Volkswagen LT cab, as near passenger car standards as a truck can be.
